# DIRECTIONS AND PARKING

Note: Parking on Seattle University campus and its surrounding neighborhood is expensive and time consuming. Allocate at least 20 minutes for driving around to find adequate and legal parking. Carpooling and taking public transportation are good alternatives.



## Location

Seattle University is located in the First Hill neighborhood in downtown Seattle. The campus is seven blocks east of Interstate 5, via the James Street exit. The street address is: 901 12<sup>th</sup> Ave, Seattle, WA 98122.

## Parking

There are three parking options:

- You may park at the 12th and E. Marion Parking Lot (Purple circle above). Pay at the yellow pay box (cash, Visa, and MasterCard) located at the center of the parking lot. Parking fees are: 0-2 hours: \$6.00, 2-4 hours: \$10.00. This lot may fill quickly.
- There are metered parking spots on both sides of 12<sup>th</sup> Ave, between E. Jefferson and E. Spring that allow to park for up to 2-hours.
- On the east side of the campus (streets parallel to 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue) residential streets allow for two hour free parking. 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenues often offer spots that are walking distance from campus.
